Do you have any travel plans for 2025? Travel companies like Conde Nast Traveler and Booking. com have shared their 2025 travel trends(趋势) predictions. These trends show how people want to find meaningful experiences from each trip they take.

Enjoy noctourism

The word “noctourism” comes from the words “nocturnal” and “tourism”. This trend is all about the beauty of traveling at night. Travelers take part in things like watching stars. As the world gets hotter, many people find it uncomfortable to go out during the day, especially in summer. They enjoy going to places to do fun activities in the cooler evenings. Others may have city tours at night or full moon picnics by the sea.

Passports to living longer

Trying to live forever might be impossible now. But our interest in living longer and healthier still stays strong. In 2025, more people will plan their trips around activities that help them live longer. For example, people will go to places that offer red light therapy(疗法) which uses red light to help make skin look better. Studies show that connecting with others makes people healthier, so many people choose activities like group hikes. In the future, travel won't just be about having fun. People will also care more about staying healthy.



Smaller and less famous

Sometimes when you are traveling, going a different way and finding cool places can be fun. Detour(绕道) travel means going to smaller, less famous places close to the main sites and spending time there. For example, the city of Reims(兰斯) is a popular detour from Paris. Tom, from the travel company Original Travel, told us that railway travel makes taking detours easy. This is because once you start looking at a train timetable, you find there are so many interesting little stops you could take.

The next day, the rain stopped and it cleared up. When the old gentleman went to pay his bill, the same clerk — the helpful young man said with a friendly smile, "The room you and your wife stayed in is not a proper guest room in this hotel, so you don't need to pay." The old gentleman nodded with thanks, "You are an employee(员工) that every boss in the hotel business would dream of. Perhaps someday I'll build a hotel for you." The clerk was amazed, but thought that the guest must have been joking.

Two years later, the young man received a letter from the old gentleman. He recalled the experience of that dark stormy night. The letter also made a formal invitation and a round-trip air ticket to New York, asking the young man to pay a visit. At a street corner in Manhattan, the young man met his former(以前的) guest. Should we use AI in schools? Some people may say no, but many experts think we should use it in a good way. They say AI



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can help us learn better.

Zheng Qinghua, president of Tongji University, said it's important for us to use AI in education. He believed that AI could help us learn new things and get better at what we study. He also suggested that young people should improve their understanding of the knowledge created by technology.

In fact, AI has already become more and more important for teaching and learning. Zheng stressed(强调) the widespread use of different models, such as Ernie Bot, an AI chatbot developed by Baidu. It can write papers, solve science problems and do homework. Students also used AI for their study. A survey made by online learning platform Study showed that 89 percent of students had used ChatGPT to help them do homework.

However, some people worry that it may bring the problem of academic integrity(学术诚信) and bad influence on education. Instead of simply using AI to give answers or finish homework and tests, people should focus on using AI to help students be creative and have the ability of solving real-world problems, said Zheng.

Colin Bailey, president of Queen Mary University of London, said that as ChatGPT develops fast, stopping AI from being used in schools is not the answer. Instead, we should think about how to use it safely and in the right way.

To achieve it, people around the world are working on rules to make sure AI is used in a good way. In the US, people are making a plan to protect people's rights with chatbots. China also has some interim measures(临时的措施) for managing AI services.
